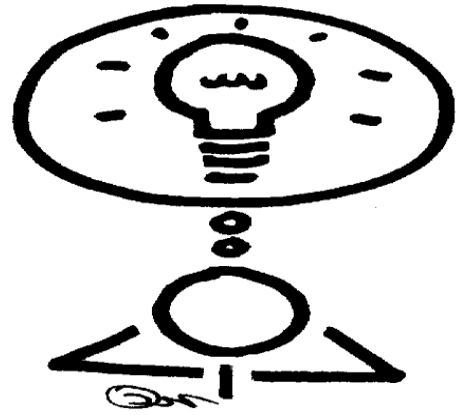


INVENTION FAIR

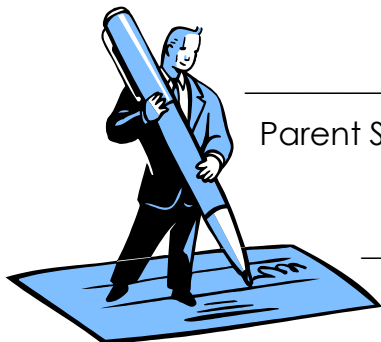
Also, continue to encourage your child to attend the Wednesday afternoon, “Invention Fair Wednesdays”. This is a great way for your child to receive help on their project.
